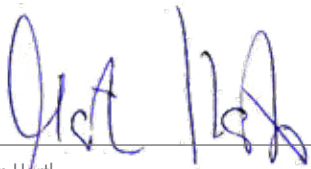


Declaration for handling "Conflict Minerals"

Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act („Dodd-Frank Act“), Section 1502

Infinex Repoly GmbH supports all efforts to prohibit the illegal trade with conflict minerals. For this we refer to section 1502 of the "Dodd-Frank Act". Its intention is that raw materials like tin, tungsten, tantalum or gold should not be sourced from the conflict regions in and around the Democratic Republic of Congo, thereby withdrawing the financial basis for wars and conflicts in these regions. We cooperate only with suppliers who source their raw materials or materials in an ethical manner. Based on the restrictions for using "Conflict Minerals", we expect from our suppliers transparency and open communication regarding source and procurement of their materials. Normally plastic products do not contain the above mentioned minerals anyway. Therefore, we declare that all of the components manufactured and delivered have to be seen as "DRC conflict free" until further notice.
